
In Re: Steven Ray Irvin, applying for supervisory writs, 22nd Judicial District Court, Parish of St. Tammany, No. 570,048.

WRIT NOT CONSIDERED. Relator failed to comply with Rules 4-5(C)(7), (8), & (9), by failing to include a copy of the judge's reasons for judgment (if any), a copy of the motion to quash, bill of information, and a copy of the opposition to the motion to quash (or a statement that no opposing written document was filed). Relator also failed to comply with Rule 4-5(C)(3), by failing to indicate the status of the case and any trial or hearing dates. Moreover, although it is not a violation of the Uniform Rules, we note that relator failed to include a copy of a transcript of the proceedings at issue. See **City of Baton Rouge v. Plain**, 433 So.2d 710 (La.), cert. denied, 464 U.S. 896, 104 S.Ct. 246, 78 L.Ed.2d 235 (1983). Supplementation of this writ application and/or an application for rehearing will not be considered. See Uniform Rules of Louisiana Courts of Appeal, Rules 2-18.7 & 4-9. In the event relator elects to file a new application with this court, the application shall be filed on or before December 10, 2018. Any future filing on this issue should include the entire contents of this application, the missing items noted above, and a copy of this ruling.
