

**WRIT DENIED.** The allegations presented in claims one, two, and three are procedurally barred as they were previously considered by this court on appeal. See La. Code Crim. P. art. 930.4(A). Relator failed to meet the criteria established in **State v. Hampton**, 2000-0522 (La. 3/22/02), 818 So.2d 720, for determining whether a defendant's right to testify was violated. Therefore, the district court did not err by not holding an evidentiary hearing and by not appointing counsel to represent relator during the postconviction proceedings.
