

WRIT DENIED. Relator is not entitled to a reduction of his statutorily-mandated life sentence pursuant to the ameliorative penalty provisions established by the Legislature in 2001 La. Acts No. 403, § 2 because he was not sentenced prior to June 15, 2001, and the underlying simple burglary offense and two of the predicate burglary convictions are felony offenses punishable by imprisonment of twelve years or more. Accordingly, the district court did not abuse its discretion by denying the motion to correct an illegal sentence.
