A writ application arising in a criminal proceeding is not the proper procedural vehicle to establish a right to records under the Louisiana Public Records Law. La. R.S. 44:1 <i>et seq</i> . Under these provisions, Simpkins is required to first make a proper request to the custodian of the records. La. R.S. 44:31 and 32. If the request for public records is denied, before seeking relief from this Court, Simpkins is required to institute civil proceedings for a writ of mandamus against the district attorney at the trial court level. La. R.S. 44:35. On the showing made, this writ is denied.
