## WRIT GRANTED AND MADE PEREMPTORY.

The applicant, Joe Butler, seeks supervisory review of the trial court's ruling denying his motion for an out of time appeal. Butler entered an unqualified plea of guilty to charges of domestic abuse battery and domestic abuse child endangerment, but sentencing was left to the trial court. After being adjudicated as a second-felony offender, he was sentenced under the Habitual Offender Law. Butler did not waive the right to seek appeal of his sentence. His motion seeking an appeal, while filed prematurely on December 11, 2023, was then cured upon the trial court's January 30, 2023, ruling denying Butler's motion to reconsider sentence. Butler's pro se motion for appeal was therefore timely under La. C. Cr. P. art. 914.

Accordingly, the writ is granted and the trial court's ruling is reversed. The

matter is remanded to the trial court for perfection of the appeal and for appointment of appellate counsel.
