Citing to *State v. Maine Labor Relations Board*, 413 A.2d 510, 513 (Me. 1980), and *Bangor Water District v. Maine Labor Relations Board*, 427 A.2d 973, 974 n.1 (Me. 1981), the court granted the Board's unopposed motion to participate as a party, though it did not conclude that the Board was a necessary or indispensable party. Because neither Trask nor the Union <u>has, on appeal</u>, challenged the order authorizing the Board's participation, we do not review the court's determination of the Board's party status.
