MEMORANDUM.

Respondent-appellant appeals as of right from the family court order terminating her parental rights to Thomas Lenell Kelly, Jr., following her voluntary release of parental rights pursuant to MCL 710.29; MSA 27.3178(555.29). We affirm.

Respondent-appellant argues that the release of her parental rights to Thomas Kelly, Jr. should be revoked for various reasons. However, because respondent-appellant did not petition the family court to revoke her release of parental rights, the issue is not properly before this Court. MCL 710.29(10); MSA 27.3178(555.29)(10); MCL 710.64; MSA 27.3178(555.64); *In re Myers*, 131 Mich App 160, 164; 345 NW2d 663 (1983).

Affirmed.
