COOPER, P.J. (*dissenting*).

I must respectfully dissent from the majority opinion of my colleagues. I would find that plaintiff's injuries affected her general ability to lead her normal life. As she was no longer able to do these activities, I would find that plaintiff met the statutory no-fault threshold. I would, therefore, reverse the trial court's dismissal of her claims.
