FINDINGS OF FACT

- $\{\P \ 1\}$ 1) On August 19, 2005, an employee of defendant, Ohio State Highway Patrol, discharged a firearm which caused damage to the vehicle of plaintiff, Harold Alexander.
- $\{\P\ 2\}$ 2) Plaintiff filed this complaint seeking to recover \$300.00, the estimated cost of vehicle repair. Plaintiff implied his property damage resulted from negligence on the part of defendant's employee. The filing fee was paid.
- $\{\P\ 3\}$ 3) Defendant admitted liability for plaintiff's property damage in the amount of \$300.00, plus \$25.00 for filing fee reimbursement.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

 $\{\P4\}$ 1) Defendant was charged with a duty to exercise reasonable care for the protection of plaintiff's property in the performance of official acts. Vastine v. State Highway Patrol, 2002-10305-AD, 2003-Ohio-1681. In regard to the facts of this claim negligence on the part of defendant has been shown. Baisden v. Southern Ohio Correctional Facility (1977), 76-0617-AD; Stewart v. Ohio National Guard (1979), 78-0342-AD.

 $\{\P 5\}$ 2) Plaintiff has suffered damages in the amount of \$300.00, plus the \$25.00 filing fee, which may be reimbursed as compensable damages pursuant to the holding in *Bailey v. Ohio Department of Rehabilitation and Correction* (1990), 62 Ohio Misc. 2d 19.
