{¶1} Steven A. Goines entered a plea of guilty to two counts of forgery as part

of a plea bargain. He was sentenced to the minimum term of six months on each

charge to be served concurrently. Goines filed a notice of appeal and, in due course,

his appointed appellate counsel filed an extensive *Anders* brief, which thoroughly

examined the record and the law and concluded that there were no meritorious issues

for appeal.

{¶2} On March 24, 2004, we informed Goines of the fact that his counsel had

filed an *Anders* brief and granted him sixty days from that date to file his pro se brief, if

any.

{¶3} No such pro se brief has been filed.

{¶4} We have thoroughly examined the record of the proceedings in this case,

and we agree with the assessment of appellate counsel that there are no meritorious

issues for appellate review.
