Crim. App. 1967). Applicant pleaded guilty and was convicted of possession with intent to deliver over 400 grams cocaine and sentenced to twenty years' imprisonment. The Fifth Court of Appeals affirmed his conviction. *Villegas v. State*, No. 05-07-00294-CR (Tex. App.–Dallas, Nov. 27, 2007, pet. ref'd).
