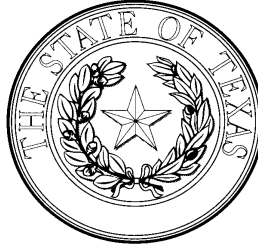

MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator, Julian Fernandez, proceeding pro se, has filed a petition for a writ of mandamus requesting that this Court “impeach the judge (administrator) and prosecutors[,] . . . and have all charges [against him] dismissed with prejudice.”¹
