MEMORANDUM OPINION

On May 21, 2010, relator, Anodizing Graphics Of Texas, Inc., filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this Court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. §22.221 (Vernon 2004); *see also* Tex. R. App. P. 52. In the petition, relator asks this Court to compel the Honorable Ben W.
