MEMORANDUM OPINION

This appeal is from a judgment signed September 17, 1990. On May 2, 1991, this court abated the appeal because appellant De Wayne Pitt petitioned for voluntary bankruptcy in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Western District of Oklahoma, under cause number 91-02487-LN. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 8.2.

This appeal has been abated and treated as a closed case since May 2, 1991. The court has not been advised that any party wishes to reinstate the appeal. On July 8, 2010, this court issued an order stating that unless any party to the appeal filed a motion demonstrating good cause to retain the appeal within twenty days of the date of the order, this appeal would be dismissed for want of prosecution. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 42.3(b). No response was filed.

Accordingly, we reinstate the appeal and order it dismissed.
