MEMORANDUM OPINION

On June 17, 2022, relator Archer Systems, LLC filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 22.221; *see also* Tex. R. App. P. 52. In the petition, relator asks this court to compel the Honorable Corey Sepolio, presiding judge of the 269th District Court of Harris County, to vacate his April 22,

2022 order denying relator's verified petition to take a deposition before suit of Stacie Burke and grant relator's request to take Burke's pre-suit deposition.¹

Relator has not established that it is entitled to mandamus relief. Accordingly, we deny relator's petition for writ of mandamus.
