PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS DENIED

On April 26, 2010, relator Jesse Morales filed a petition for writ of mandamus, complaining that the trial court has failed or refused to order the clerk of the court to forward a copy of the Judgment Nunc Pro Tunc that granted him 721 days jail time credit. However, the record indicates the trial court did forward the Judgment Nunc Pro Tunc and relator was given the appropriate jail time credit of 721 days. As a result of the foregoing, relator's petition for writ of mandamus is DENIED.
