PETITION FOR WRIT OF MANDAMUS DENIED

On June 15, 2017, relators Adan Volpe Properties, Ltd., and Maricela Volpe, General Partner, filed a petition for writ of mandamus, complaining of the trial court's order compelling arbitration and its refusal to rule on their motion for summary judgment. Relators also filed a motion for emergency stay, which was granted on June 16, 2017.
