**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Relator William E. Durham filed a petition for writ of mandamus, in which he apparently seeks an order compelling the trial court to grant him a new trial in his underlying criminal case. Durham's appeal is currently pending before this Court in Cause No. 09-11-00475-CR. We may grant mandamus relief only if the relator demonstrates that the act sought to be compelled is purely ministerial, and that the relator has no other adequate legal remedy. *See State ex rel. Hill v. Court of Appeals for the Fifth Dist.*, 34 S.W.3d 924, 927 (Tex. Crim. App. 2001). The petition for writ of mandamus is denied.
