**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

On February 9, 2017, we notified the parties that the appeal would be dismissed for want of prosecution unless arrangements were made for filing the record or the appellant explained why he needed more time for filing the record. The appellant did not file a response. It appears that the appellant is not entitled to proceed without payment of costs. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 20.2. There being no satisfactory explanation for the failure to file the record, the appeal is dismissed for want of prosecution. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 37.3(b).
