MEMORANDUM OPINION

On April 4, 2017, we notified the parties that the appeal would be dismissed for want of prosecution unless arrangements were made for filing the clerk's record or the appellant explained why additional time was needed to file the record. Appellant did not respond to the Court's notice.

Appellant did not file an affidavit of indigence and is not entitled to proceed without payment of costs. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 20.1. There being no satisfactory explanation for the failure to file the clerk's record, we dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 37.3(b); Tex. R. App. P. 42.3.

APPEAL DISMISSED.
