MEMORANDUM OPINION¹ AND JUDGMENT

Appellant Andre Huey-You's brief was originally due on November 16, 2016. On December 5, 2016, we notified Appellant that his brief had not been filed as required by Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 38.6(a). See Tex. R. App. P. 38.6(a). We stated we could dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution unless appellant or any party desiring to continue this appeal filed with the court within ten days a response showing grounds for continuing the appeal. See Tex.

R. App. P. 42.3. We received a motion from Appellant requesting an extension until January 9, 2017. Appellant, however, did not file his brief.

On January 23, 2017, we again notified appellant that his brief had not been filed as required by Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 38.6(a) and stated we could dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution unless appellant or any party desiring to continue this appeal filed with the court within ten days a response showing grounds for continuing the appeal. See Tex. R. App. P. 38.6(a), 42.3. We have not received any response.

Because Appellant's brief has not been filed, we dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution. See Tex. R. App. P. 38.8(a), 42.3(b), 43.2(f).

Appellant shall pay all costs of this appeal, for which let execution issue.
