Appellant Robert Eugene Ghering attempts to appeal his conviction for unauthorized use of a vehicle. The trial court's certification states that this "is a plea-bargain case, and the defendant has NO right of appeal." See Tex. R. App. P. 25.2(a)(2). On May 17, 2017, we notified Ghering that this appeal may be dismissed pursuant to the trial court's certification unless he or any party desiring
