Appellant Hugo Gomez pleaded guilty to sexual assault of a child under 17 years of age in exchange for waiver of two criminal counts and a sentence of thirty years' confinement. He now attempts to appeal this conviction. On June 23, 2017, we notified appellant that the trial court's certification of his right to appeal states that this is a plea-bargain case and that he has no right of appeal.
