MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator Michael Lou Garrett seeks a writ of mandamus ordering respondent, the Honorable John B. Board, Judge of the 181st District Court of Potter County, to rule on a motion pending in cause number 91,954-B. We dismiss the petition.

Relator filed his petition for a writ of mandamus with this Court on November 18, 2004. In the petition he complains that Judge Board has failed to rule on relator's motion for a temporary restraining order and a preliminary injunction.
