MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant, Christopher Zeiss, perfected an appeal from the trial court's order granting Citibank's Motion for Summary Judgment. The parties have filed a Joint Motion to Dismiss Appeal asserting that the parties have reached a settlement agreement. The joint motion requests that this court vacate the trial court's judgment without regard to the merits and dismiss the appeal. This disposition is authorized by rules 42.1(a)(2)(A) and 43.2(e) of the Texas Rules of Appellate Procedure.
