MEMORANDUM OPINION

Before QUINN, C.J., and CAMPBELL and HANCOCK, JJ.

The court abated the appeal of appellant Don Eric Wolters and remanded the cause to the trial court on November 20, 2015. On December 8, appellant filed a motion to dismiss the appeal.
