## MEMORANDUM OPINION

Before QUINN, C.J., and CAMPBELL and HANCOCK, JJ.

On February 1, 2016, appellant, George Jones, filed a motion to dismiss appeal that complies with the requirements of Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 42.1(a)(1). Appellee, Ellen Copeland, has filed a response indicating that she is unopposed to appellant's motion to dismiss.
