MEMORANDUM OPINION

Before QUINN, C.J., and DOSS and YARBROUGH, JJ.

Appellant, Christian Angel Zubia, appealed his conviction for murder¹ and sentence to seventy years inprisonment. On March 27, 2024, we remanded the cause to the trial court after Appellant's counsel failed to timely file a brief. While on remand, Appellant filed a motion to voluntarily dismiss the appeal. As required by Rule of Appellate Procedure 42.2(a), the motion to dismiss is signed by Appellant and his attorney. As no
