Floyd Tarvin, IV filed a notice of appeal on October 9, 2014. By letter dated February 3, 2015, this Court notified Tarvin that the appeal was subject to dismissal for want of jurisdiction. The Clerk also warned Tarvin that the appeal would be dismissed unless, within 21 days of the date of the letter, a response was filed showing grounds for continuing the appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. Because there is no final appealable order in this case, we dismiss this appeal for lack of jurisdiction.
