Because appellants David Pulliam and Adela Pulliam have failed to file an appellants= brief, we will dismiss this appeal for want of prosecution. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 38.8(a)(1), 42.3(b).

The Clerk of this Court filed the clerks record in this cause on March 25, 2002 and the reporters record on April 4. Thus, appellants brief was due May 6. *See id.* 38.6(a)(2). By postcard dated June 3, 2002, the Clerk of this Court notified the parties that the appeal was subject to dismissal for want of prosecution unless appellants tendered a motion for extension of time by June 13, reasonably explaining the failure to file a brief. *See id.* 38.8(a)(1). Thus far, appellants have submitted neither a brief nor a motion for extension of time to file a brief.

Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution on our own motion. *See id.* 42.3(b).
