MEMORANDUM OPINION

Because appellant Kamelsh Narayanji Hariyani has failed to file an appellate brief, we will dismiss this appeal for want of prosecution. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 42.3(b), (c).

The Clerk of this Court filed appellant's notice of appeal and the clerk's record on January 2, 2003. On February 13, the court reporter informed this Court that no reporter's record has been requested. Consequently, the appellant's brief was due on February 3, 2003. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 38.6(a). On February 26, 2003, the Clerk of this Court informed appellant that unless a proper motion is submitted to this Court by March 3, this Court will dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution. Thus far, appellant has failed to respond to this request.

Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution on our own motion. *See id.*
