MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator Robert Troy McClure has filed a pro se petition for writ of Habeas Corpus in this Court. Intermediate courts of appeals lack jurisdiction to grant habeas corpus relief from final felony convictions. *See* Tex. Code Crim. Proc. Ann. art. 11.07 (West Supp. 2012) (procedure for application for writ of habeas corpus); *Board of Pardons & Paroles ex rel. Keene v. Court of Appeals for Eighth Dist.*, 910 S.W.2d 481, 483 (Tex. Crim. App. 1995); *In re Watson*, 253 S.W.3d 319, 320 (Tex. App.—Amarillo 2008, orig. proceeding). Accordingly, we dismiss McClure’s petition for want of jurisdiction.¹
