MEMORANDUM OPINION

The notice of appeal in this cause was filed on May 17, 2005. On October 19, 2005, after receiving a Suggestion of Bankruptcy filed in the trial court by appellants, we abated the appeal. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 8.1, 8.2. After the abatement, no party to this appeal sought reinstatement or otherwise advised the Court of the status of the bankruptcy proceeding. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 8.3. We have now been informed that the bankruptcy case related to this appeal was closed on March 31, 2006.¹

On October 27, 2016, this Court notified the parties that this appeal would be dismissed for want of prosecution unless they filed a status report by November 7, providing any reason to retain this appeal. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 42.3(b). No response was filed.

¹ We considered this appeal as part of an ongoing review of cases that were abated for bankruptcy but did not reflect a final disposition or current status report from the parties.

We therefore reinstate the appeal and dismiss it for want of prosecution.
