MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant Amos Simms seeks to appeal a judgment of conviction for possession of a controlled substance. *See* Tex. Health & Safety Code § 481.116(c). The trial court has certified that (1) this is a plea-bargain case and Simms has no right of appeal, and (2) Simms has waived the right of appeal. Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal for want of jurisdiction. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 25.2(a)(2), (d).
