# **MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Before Chief Justice Valdez and Justices Yañez and Vela Memorandum Opinion Per Curiam

Appellants, Ariel Chavez and Oscar Chavez, perfected an appeal from a judgment entered by the County Court at Law No. 1 of Cameron County, Texas, in cause number 2005-CCL-1432-A. Appellants have filed an agreed motion to dismiss the appeal on
