MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant, Jose Luis Aguilar, pro se perfected an appeal from a judgment entered

by the 343rd District Court of Bee County, Texas, in cause number B-08-1001-CV-C.

Appellant has filed a motion stating the trial court's judgment constitutes no appealable
