Memorandum Opinion Per Curiam<sup>1</sup>**

Relators, Golden Corral Corporation and David Uribe, filed petitions for writ of mandamus on June 15, 2011. Relators have now filed motions to dismiss these original proceedings on grounds that the trial court has entered an order dismissing this matter and the petitions for writ of mandamus are now moot.
