MOORE, Chief Justice (dissenting).

I would grant T.G.'s petition for a writ of certiorari in this termination-of-parental-rights case to determine whether there is "evidence of <u>current</u> conditions or conduct" relating to T.G.'s alleged "inability or unwillingness to care for his ... children." <u>D.O. v. Calhoun Cnty. Dep't of Human Res.</u>, 859 So. 2d 439, 444 (Ala. Civ. App. 2003). Therefore, I respectfully dissent.
