IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Petition for Rehearing is **GRANTED**.
2. Opinion No. 7403 issued on August 30, 2019, is **WITHDRAWN** and Opinion No. 7414 is issued on October 11, 2019, in its place. The revised opinion incorporates the following changes to footnote 28.

Annette and Matthew themselves speculated during the adjudication hearing that one or more visitors to their home may have exposed Justin to methamphetamine. The parties agreed that the court could consider this evidence at the termination trial. *See Carla W. v. State, Office of Children's Servs.*, 2008 WL 5352295 *5 (Alaska Dec. 24, 2008 (unpublished)).
