APPEAL MOOT.

J.E.M. appeals from the circuit court's judgment in which it found that his consent to the adoption of his putative son, Baby Boy B., was not required under Arkansas Code Annotated § 9-9-206 (Repl. 2009). The judgment was entered in both the guardianship and adoption proceedings involving Baby Boy B., and a petition for adoption by G.F.J. and S.L.J. was eventually granted. The instant appeal involving the guardianship proceeding is identical to the appeal involving the adoption proceeding submitted simultaneously to this court, in that the same judgment is challenged and the same points on appeal are raised. Because the issues in this appeal are disposed of by our decision in *In re Adoption of Baby Boy B., a Minor*, 2012 Ark. 92, delivered this same day, the instant appeal is moot.
