PER CURIAM

On August 17, 2009, petitioner Emmett Michael Brim filed in this court a petition for writ of mandamus, in which he alleged that the Honorable Robert Bynum Gibson, Jr., Circuit Judge, had failed to act upon a petition for writ of habeas corpus filed on May 12, 2008, in Chicot County Circuit Court in a timely manner. Judge Gibson has since filed a response to the petition in this court in which he notes that a response was filed to the habeas petition in December of 2008, and that a ruling has now been provided.

The circuit court has entered an order that disposed of the habeas petition.¹ As the court has acted on that petition, the petition for writ of mandamus is moot.
