ORDER MODIFYING OPINION AND  
DENYING REHEARING

[NO CHANGE IN JUDGMENT]

THE COURT:

It is ordered that the opinion filed herein on November 18, 2004, be modified as follows:

On page 18, the last full sentence beginning "Finally, the People's contention that counsel was not ineffective for failing to call Callahan to testify . . ." is deleted and replaced with the following:

Finally, the People's contention that counsel was not ineffective for failing to call Callahan to testify is premised in large part on a factual assertion that is not supported by the record.
