ORDER MODIFYING OPINION

NO CHANGE IN THE JUDGMENT

THE COURT:

It is ordered that the opinion filed herein on January 28, 2013, be modified as follows:

1. On page 12 of the Concurrence, line 4, the word “distinguished” is changed to “did not distinguish” so that the sentence reads:

In summary, though the court in *Howard N.* did not distinguish dangerous juvenile offenders from SVPs for purposes of requiring a finding of a dangerous lack of self-control (*Howard N.*, *supra*, 35 Cal.4th 117, 128), two years later the court articulated significant differences between such offenders in *Lemanuel C.*

There is no change in the judgment.
