Dear Counsel:

I have waited until after the legislative session to see whether or not certain proposed legislation would be acted upon by the House and the Senate. When the June 30<sup>th</sup> clock ran out, it was still being massaged and therefore nothing new is on the books this year.

As to the present petition, I note that it seeks to expunge a Title 21 offense of disregarding a red light in which she received probation before judgment and was discharged. She also has another Title 21 offense in which she pled guilty, i.e. a speeding ticket. Therefore, after considering whether or not the continued existence and possible dissemination of the information concerning a rules of the road Title 21 offense causes manifest injustice and considering that she has a conviction on her driving record, I deny the application for expungement of criminal record.
