**ORDER**

This 21st day of April 2009, after careful consideration of the parties' briefs and the record below, we find it manifest that the judgment below should be affirmed on the basis of the Superior Court's well-reasoned decision dated July 1, 2008. The Superior Court did not err in concluding that appellant's third motion for postconviction relief was procedurally barred and that appellant had failed to overcome the procedural hurdles of Superior Court Criminal Rule 61(i)(2) and (i)(4).<sup>1</sup>
