ORDER

This 22nd day of February 2016, it appears to the Court that, on December 3, 2015, the Chief Deputy Clerk issued a notice to the appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for his failure to file his opening brief and appendix in this matter by the November 2, 2015 deadline. On January 5, 2016, the notice to show cause was re-sent to the appellant at his New York address. The appellant responded by asking for more time to file his brief.
