ORDER

This 14th day of June 2018, after careful consideration of the appellant’s opening brief, the appellee’s motion to affirm, and the record below, we conclude that the judgment below should be affirmed on the basis of the Superior Court’s March 29, 2018 order denying the appellant’s third motion for postconviction relief.¹ The Superior Court did not err in concluding that the motion was procedurally barred by Superior Court Criminal Rule 61 and that the appellant had failed to overcome the procedural hurdles.
