**ORDER**

On July 24, 2019, the Senior Court Clerk sent a letter directing the appellant to pay the Family Court filing fee on or before August 6, 2019, or this Court would issue a notice to show cause why the appeal should not be dismissed. On August 7, 2019, the Senior Court Clerk issued a notice, sent by certified mail, directing the appellant to show cause why this appeal should not be dismissed for the appellant's failure to pay the Family Court filing fee. Postal records indicate that the notice to show cause was delivered on August 9, 2019. The appellant did not respond to the notice to show cause within the required ten-day period; therefore, dismissal of this action is deemed to be unopposed.
