**ORDER**

After careful consideration of the appellant’s opening brief, the motion to affirm, and the record on appeal, we conclude that the judgment below should be affirmed on the basis of and for the reasons assigned by the Superior Court’s order, dated December 21, 2018, dismissing the appellant’s third motion for postconviction relief.
