**ORDER**

On May 15, 2023, the appellant, Frank Nelson, filed a notice of appeal from an April 6, 2023 Family Court order finding him in contempt and entering a monetary judgment in favor of the appellee, Gillian Nelson. The Senior Court Clerk issued, by certified mail, a notice directing Nelson to show cause why his appeal should not be dismissed as untimely filed.<sup>2</sup> An unsigned and undated return receipt was filed with the Court on May 30, 2023. The Senior Court Clerk reissued, by both certified and first-class mail, the notice to show cause on June 13, 2023. To date,

Nelson has not responded to the notice to show cause. Dismissal of the appeal is therefore deemed to be unopposed.
